

# EXAMPLE EVENT REGULATIONS

Nora 92 affiliated organisers may wish to produce Event Regulations for their individual events and championships. These regulations should give the specific rules and details for the event in question. The Event Regulations should, where practicable, display the Circuit Certificate and Event Permit numbers.

Below is a suggested layout for a set of Event Regulations, showing the information that should be contained in each section.
