Organising Motorsport Events – COVID Restrictions

As a recognised issuing body of Motorsport RTA exemption Permits under the auspices of The Motor Vehicles (Off Road Events) Regulations 1995, NORA 92 Ltd have been working hard for the past twelve months to ensure that any activities undertaken by affiliated organisers are done so in a responsible manner and are in compliance with the local regulations in place as issued by the respective authorities of the UK

With the varying guidance in place, depending upon location, this has proved to be a very difficult task and we have been working closely with all of our individual affiliated organisers to ensure that they are aware of their duties within their local area.

At this point we would like to assure you that our affiliated organisers work not only within our general set of comprehensive Codes, Rules, Regulations and Guidance, but also adhere to our specific Coronavirus Risk Assessment, Method Statement and Rules for Attendees which are monitored and updated on a regular basis as guidance evolves and is issued from the varying Governments. The organisers will be able to submit this paperwork to you along with the relevant exemption permit and summary proof of insurance for their venue.

As a body that regulates all forms of Off Road Motorsport we have a robust insurance policy in place that affords £20 million of Public Liability across ALL events, practice and training sessions, this cover extends to all parties, including landowners, involved in an event. We work very closely with our insurance provider and they are satisfied that we are doing everything in our power to mitigate the opportunity to spread the virus and are happy for us to proceed with events within the parameters that we have laid out.

As a responsible body we are keen that we can offer as safe an environment as possible for participants to reengage in this sporting activity under controlled conditions and within permitted guidance, working within the government roadmap for the release from lockdown.
