



RULES FOR ATTENDANCE AT NORA 92 EVENTS

Effective 17th May 2021

All persons attending an event sanctioned by NORA 92 Limited must adhere to the following set of guidelines. These guidelines are in place to protect everybody on site and it is the responsibility of all attendees to manage their own safety as well as the safety of others. The organisers are following a strict regime of Health and Safety measures aimed at limiting the potential spread of COVID 19 in all of its variants. Please show courtesy to the people that are putting themselves at risk to stage the event for you and abide by all instructions given to you.

1. Number of Attendees

The venue will determine the number of attendees allowed on site, to enable the maximum number of competitors there are restrictions in place on size of parties

1.1 Competitors

Competitors may attend the event only with other persons from the same household

1.2 Spectators

Spectators will be allowed up to a maximum of 4000 or %50 of capacity, whichever is the lowest.

1.3 Track and Trace

It is a legal requirement that all person in attendance over the age of 16 leave contact details with the organiser or scan in using the NHS Track and Trace QR code.

2. Event Entries

Competitors must book to attend the event in advance, supplying full contact details. The use of cash payments is discouraged.

3. Event Licences

Competitors are requested to arrange in advance to be the holders of either an annual NORA 92 licence or a 2021 One Event Licence Card, both are available through nora92.com. This will alleviate the need for filling forms at the event.

4. Signing On

Only one person at a time will be allowed to attend the sign on desk and facemasks must be worn, competitors are requested to use their own pens for signing on. Signing on may also be conducted at the entrance to the venue as long as it does not create a hazard by causing queues on to the highway.

5. Vulnerable Persons

Person more susceptible to contracting the virus are requested not to attend an event

6. Persons showing symptoms

Any person that has been showing symptoms of the virus within 10 days of the event is requested not to attend unless they have a negative test result.

Any person that develops symptoms of the virus whilst at the venue is requested to inform the organisers and leave the site immediately



7. COVID tests

Rapid lateral flow test kits are now available from the NHS in England. It is recommended that participants conduct a test prior to attending the event and not to attend following a positive result.

8. Temperature Checks

You may be subjected to a non-contact temperature check prior to being given access to the site.

9. Face coverings

Face coverings are not required at outdoor venues. However, you must have a face covering when you cannot remain 2m distanced and must wear one when attending signing on.

10. Social Distancing

The rule of 30 will be in place at the event – person from any number of households may congregate in groups of no more than thirty when outside. Outside of this group the 2m distancing rule must be observed.

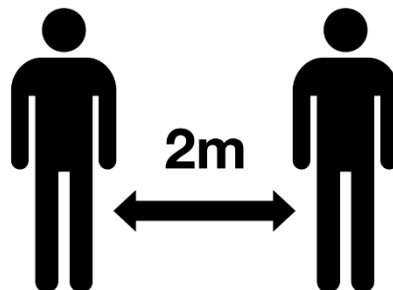
11. Hygiene

Hand sanitiser will be available, it is the responsibility of all attendees to ensure that they regularly wash and sanitise their hands.

12. Overnight Stays

People are allowed to stay overnight on site in self-contained accommodation, social gatherings MUST observe the same rules as laid out above. Indoor gatherings must not exceed 6 people, this includes vehicles.
